THE FAIRER FUTURES PROGRAMME

The Fairer Futures Programme supports 19-35 year olds in Walsall who have been out of work for 6 months or more, specialising in learners with SEND and other barriers to employment. During this 10 to 12 week programme learners gain a Level 1 in Work skills, Level 2 in Food Hygiene and preparation, extensive interview preparation, support with job applications/ CVs, and 6 weeks of work experience.
